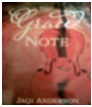
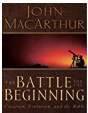


Book Recommendations

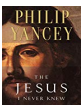

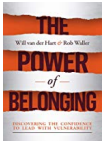

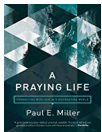
